# Wedding Symbols and Superstitions

What will bring good luck to the bride and groom on their wedding day? Different cultures have different beliefs, but nearly all do something to wish the couple a long and happy marriage. In Italy, it's (1) Custoway for the wedding guests to tie a ribbon in front of the building where the couple will marry. This is a (2) Symbol of the couple's bond of marriage. There is another tradition in which the bride gives guests "confetti," which can be in the form of rice, paper, nuts, or candy covered almonds.
